POSITION: Civic Engagement Canvasser - Fall 2024

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

BLU Educational Foundation sees civic engagement as key to our mission of working with the community for educational, economic, social, and racial justice. To support this work, BLU is partnered with the California Black Power Network, a coalition of organizations dedicated to increasing the Black community's involvement and participation in the policymaking process. This work seeks to inform community members and enhance voter engagement throughout the state through various civic engagement efforts.

POSITION SUMMARY

The **Civic Engagement Canvasser** will engage African American/Black and other communities of color to increase the power, voice and leadership of their communities to advance educational and social justice. The Canvasser will survey community members via phone and door to door regarding the improvement of economic mobility of low-income communities through the lens of labor, housing, education, environmental justice, economic development, arts/culture, and healthcare.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Attending (1) Mandatory Team Training to prepare for BLU's Civic Engagement Efforts for the November General Election
- Door to door canvassing and phone banking to talk and survey community members
- Accurately record survey recipient information

QUALIFICATIONS

- MUST enjoy and be willing to effectively engage with the African American/Black community
- Interest/experience with phone banks, door-to-door work, voter/community outreach
- Excellent communication skills and be comfortable speaking with strangers
- Comfortable using the computer and engagement technologies
- Energetic and outgoing personality
- Must be able to walk for long periods of time and walk up steps and hills
- Must carry self in a professional and ethical manner
- Must be well groomed, inclusive of attire and personal hygiene
- Dependability and punctuality are a must!

REQUIREMENTS

Education: High School diploma/GED

Must have personal transportation available, CA Driver's License and auto insurance

SALARY AND BENEFITS

\$22-23 an hour and daily lunch provided. This is a part-time, temporary position. Benefits are not included, however incentive opportunities are available based on performance
